#### Schengen Rules & Regulations

#### Schengen States

 Austria, Belgium, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, France, Finland, Italy, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxemburg, Malta, Netherland, Norway, Portugal, Poland, Spain, Sweden, Slovenia, Slovakia, Switzerland.

#### Schengen Common Visa rule

- If you intend to visit only one Schengen country and if it is Italy, you must apply for a visa at Embassy of Italy, Yaoundé.
- If you intend to visit several Schengen countries and your duration of stay remains longest in one particular country, you are requested to apply for visa at Embassy or Consulate of that particular Schengen country where you will stay for longer period.
- If you intend to visit several Schengen countries and duration of stay in those countries are same, you are requested to apply for a visa at the Embassy or Consulate to the first country you enter.

### Short Stay

- First Time Tourist, Frequent Tourist
- First Time Business, Frequent Business
- Conference, Public Meetings, Sports Activities Government Official Visit
- Medical (Stay within 90 calendar days).
  Student on vocational study (Stay within 90 Days)
